These custom made pillowcases make great gifts for every one on your gift list. Use them as 'gift wrappers' when you have a large gift to give. Just follow the simple directions, and in no time at all, you will have a great collection of beautiful custom gifts.

Don't forget to make several for yourself.

1. Select three fabrics that compliment each other. One for the body of the case, one for the cuff, and one as the accent. The accent could also be a piece of lace. Your selections can be made to fit the interest and hobbies of the recipient. Be Creative, try something unusual. Almost anything will work well.
2. Fabric requirements, all cut selvage to selvage (STS)
Body, $\frac{3}{4}$ yard (One yard if you are making King Size).
Cuff, $\frac{1}{4}$ yard. Select something that compliments your body fabric
Accent, $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch piece. If you are using lace, select something about $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches wide.
3. Prepare the fabrics this way: Cuff piece, press in half, so that it measures $4\frac{1}{2} \times 44$ inches. Accent piece, press in half, so that it measures $1\frac{1}{4} \times 44$ inches.
4. Layer all three pieces this way, matching the raw edges, STS.
 - A. The body
 - B. The accent piece
 - C. The cuffYou are going to sew all three together, in the order they are layered.
5. Using your regular sewing machine or serger, sew all the layers together, STS.
6. Press the accent strip either to the cuff side, or the body side, you decide which you like best. The effect is different each way.
7. Fold in half, right sides together, (RST). Place the fold on the left side. Measure from the fold $20\frac{1}{2}$ inches. Cut the pillowcase at that mark, from top to bottom.
8. Sew along the long side, RST, then at the pillowcase bottom opening. Turn right side out. Press if desired. See how easy it was! Go forth and make more!!
